The Kennesaw Mountain Writing Project, a site of the National Writing Project (NWP), focuses on the core mission of improving the teaching of writing and improving the use of writing across the disciplines by offering high-quality professional development programs for educators in their service areas, at all grade levels, K–16 and across the curriculum. The Invitational Summer Institute (ISI) is at the core of the NWP's model of "teachers teaching teachers."

The multi-week ISI is a workshop designed to be both more demanding and more fulfilling than traditional staff development programs. Also, the ISI connects to the National Writing Project's philosophy that teachers improve their own teaching practices by working with other outstanding teachers in group-learning activities.
